

**OFFICE ORDER**  
**FOR OPENING OF OFFLINE MODE OF CLASSES**

**05/12/2021**

Following the orders of Higher Education, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh, **SVKM's NMIMS Indore** opened the Offline/Physical Mode of Classes w.e.f 6<sup>th</sup> December 2021 considering the following facts:

1. The novel coronavirus ("COVID-19") is a disease that includes several symptoms according to the W.H.O, such as fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath, nausea, and can lead to death. Even after taking both the doses of Covid19 vaccination, COVID-19 is contagious and means that contact with others, even those who are asymptomatic, or contact with surfaces that have been exposed to the virus, can lead to infection.
2. Student and Parents understand and acknowledge the orders of Higher Education, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh, the Reopening guidelines of SVKM's NMIMS Indore and the WHO guidelines regarding COVID-19. Also, they acknowledge and understand that the circumstances regarding COVID-19 are changing from day to day and that; accordingly, Central & State orders and guidance are regularly modified and updated. It is the responsibility of Student and Parent for familiarizing themselves with the most recent updates and complying with it at all times while on the Institute's property.
3. The Institute is dedicated to provide a safe community to its faculty, staff, students, and visitors. However, it is to note that it is impossible for the Institute to prevent all risk of infection. Student and Parents acknowledge that the Institute has done its best to implement recommended CDC, Department of Public Health, state and local guidelines and put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, the Institute cannot guarantee that one will not be infected with COVID-19.
4. It is understood that Institute has put in place new policies and protocols in order to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. Student and Parent have read and agree to abide by the Institute's policies and protocols for COVID-19 at all times while on the Institute's property.
5. By reading this order, Student and Parent acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19, the fact that it can be difficult to identify in another, and the inherent risk of exposure in service to the Institute to those who may be infected with COVID-19. Student and Parent acknowledge the risk that one may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by their presence on the property or in service of the Institute and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and/or death.

6. Student and Parent understand and acknowledge that given the unknown nature of COVID-19, it is not possible to fully list each and every individual risk of contracting COVID-19. Student and Parent understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at the Institute may result from the actions, omission, or negligence of themselves and others, including but not limited to, Institute trustees, employees, agents, contractors, volunteers, and students. Student and Parent acknowledge that the Institute is an open campus, which limits the Institute's ability to control students and visitors on campus. Student and Parent recognize that the Institute cannot limit all potential sources of COVID-19 infection. Student and Parent acknowledge that they have asked for and/or been given any information that they may need to determine the risks associated with returning to the premises of the Institute and to make an informed decision of those risks.
7. Student and Parent understand and consent to submit and comply with any testing, health monitoring and contact tracing protocols that the Institute has determined are prudent to maintain a safe campus environment. Student and Parent understand that the Institute will take reasonable measures to ensure the confidential and private nature of the testing and health monitoring information it may obtain from students and employees. However, Student and Parent understand and agree that the Institute may share Student's COVID-19-related information with certain employees and/or public health officials with a legitimate need to know this information.

**Institute will continue following the orders of Higher Education, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh and will conduct only Offline/Physical Mode of Classes. Any change made by the Higher Education, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh will be timely notify to students.**

**Student attending Offline/Physical Mode of Classes have to compulsorily submit the hard copy of filled & signed Undertaking given by Govt. of Madhya Pradesh and Covid19 Vaccination certificates of both the doses.**
